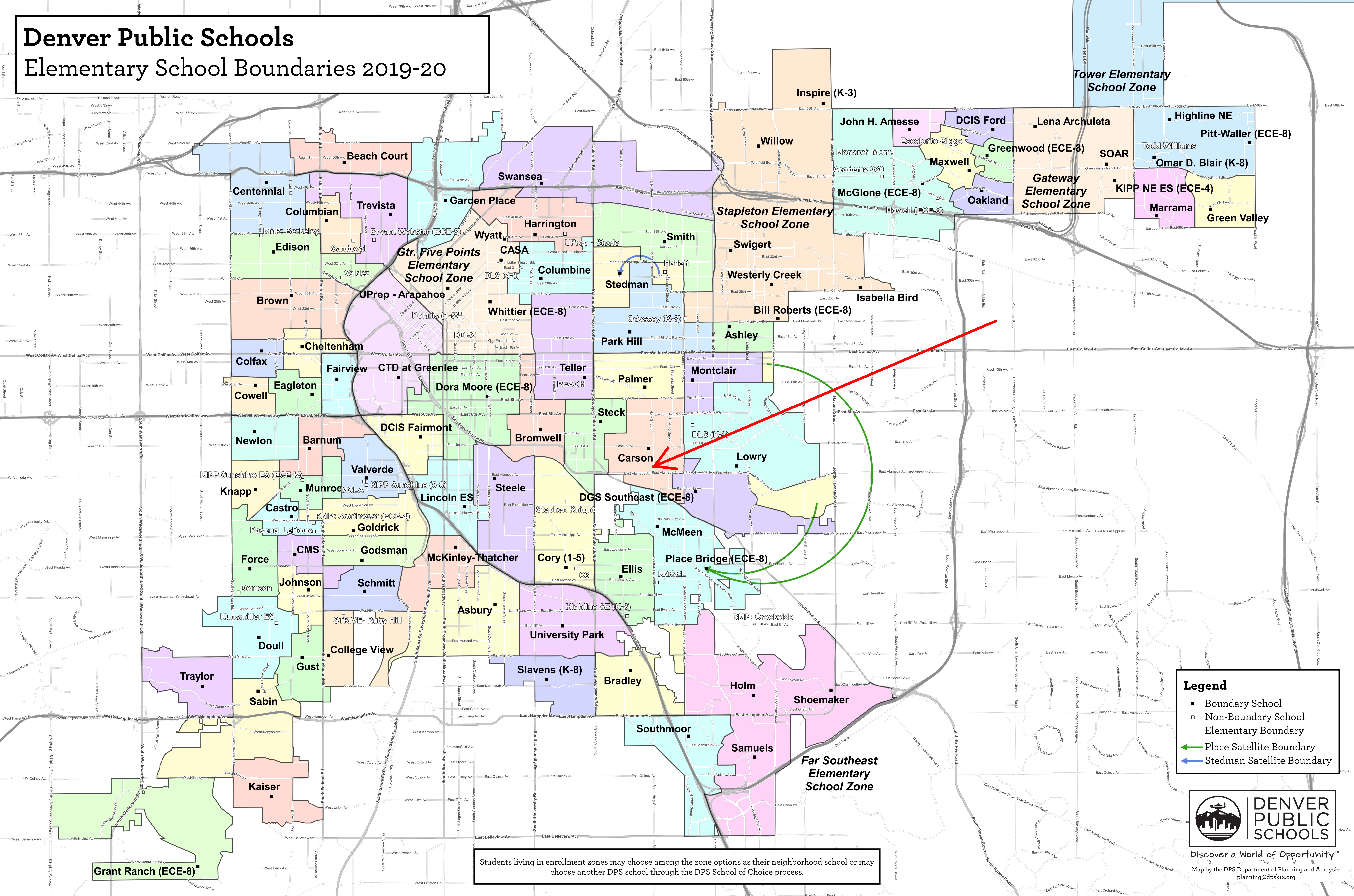
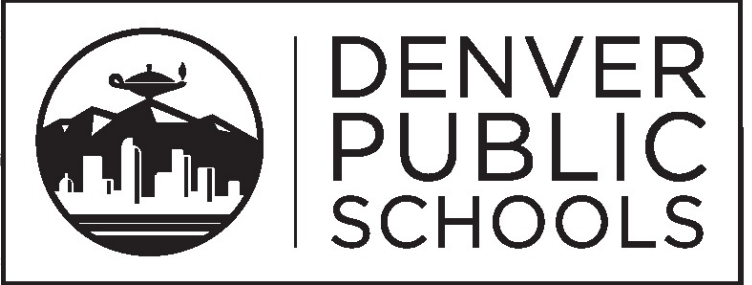


# Denver Public Schools Elementary School Boundaries 2019-20
