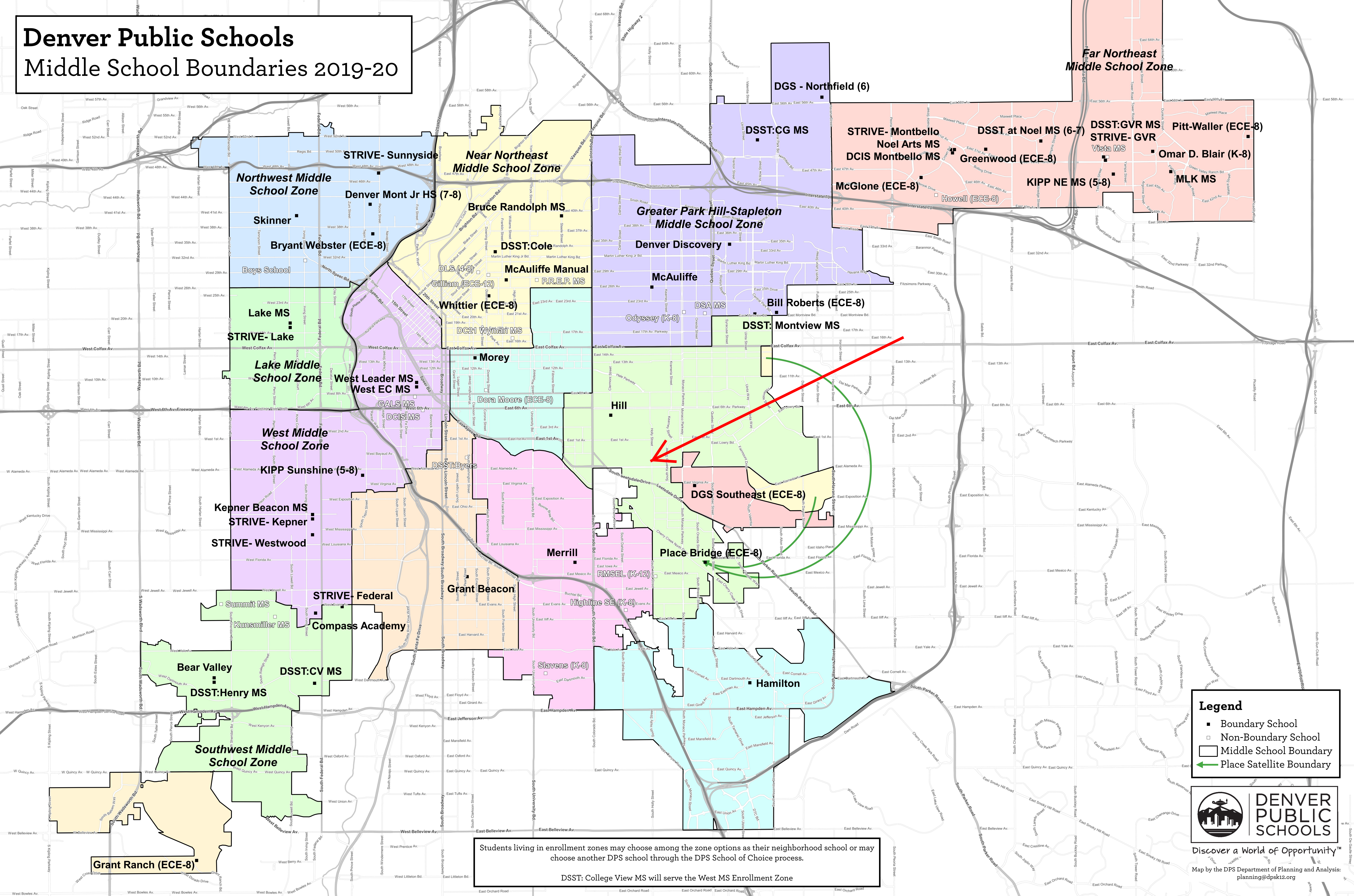
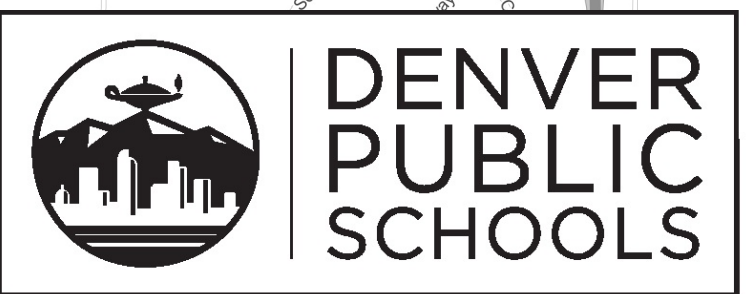


# Denver Public Schools Middle School Boundaries 2019-20
